

National Centre for Disease Control has prepared **Draft Risk Communication Plan** in consultation with the experts from fields of communication and Medicine. The Central Government is required to enlist all the stakeholders so as to bring about effective prevention & control of emergency situations involving risk to persons/ communities by effective Risk Communication so that the health risk to the communities is minimized. The National Risk Communication Plan is towards fulfilment of compliance to International Health Regulations (2005). The document is placed at the website of NCDC for information of all stakeholders likely to be affected during such emergencies for enlisting their support.

Any suggestions/comments/ objection which may be received from any person with respect to the said draft National Risk Communication document before expiry of one month from the date of uploading it on the website of NCDC will be considered by National Centre for Disease Control.
