Brief of work during period of Internship

1. Get overall understanding of Climate Change and Health by rotation among officers working on different subject areas at the Centre.
2. Identify area of interest by candidate during rotation at the Centre.
3. Literature review on area of interest related to climate change and specific exposure/outcome identified by the candidate.
4. Support in developing IEC content, training modules, guidelines, newsletters, managing surveillance and alerts etc. under the NPCCHH programme on area of interest identified for the candidate.
5. Review State and District level action plans on Climate Change and Health and provide constructive feedback and support to update the action plans.
6. Candidates who are interested and can self-sponsor themselves can spend a short while at state or district of their choice in concurrence with the state or district nodal officer under NPCCHH to understand ground work in the programme.
